



New High Chair Regulations Effective June 19, 2019

A new federal standard (ATSM F404-18) was approved by the Consumer Product Safety Commission to improve the safety of high chairs in the United States. This regulation went into effect on all high chairs manufactured or imported after June 19, 2019.

All Adcraft high chairs are complaint with ASTM Standards

All high chairs meet the following standards:



ACTIVE THREE-POINT RESTRAINT An active three-point restraint system is required



PERMANENT T-BAR RESTRAINT T-Bar remains in a fixed position at all times

HIGH CHAIR STABILITY

Chairs have rearward stability and do not tip over when pulled forward, backward or sideways by specified force
