

HOW TO OPERATE YOUR UNDERCOUNTER DISHWASHER



The word **FIL** will scroll across the display during the fill and heat process.



When complete, a temperature will display in the screen

Press the on/off switch once.

Open the door. Place the rack of items to be washed in the unit. Close the door.



Press a button for the wash cycle you need. 1st cycle for glasses or 2nd cycle for dishes. When complete, the word **End** will appear and the unit will beep.

HOW TO RUN A CLEAN CYCLE, TAKE APART AND CLEAN YOUR UNDERCOUNTER DISHWASHER

STEP 1

Take Apart



Open the door and remove the dishrack (if there is one in the unit).



Remove the strainer pan



Remove the overflow pipe

STEP 2

Run a clean cycle



Close the door and **press the drain cycle button once**



The **Clean message CLE** will be displayed throughout the drain cycle (which runs approximately for 3 minutes)



The word **End** will display when the cycle is over and the machine will beep. **You can now open the door and press the off button**

STEP 3

Take apart



Turn counter clockwise to remove the pump filter



Unscrew the lower rinse arm. Lift the wash arm. Remove both and clean.



STEP 4

Take apart



Unscrew the upper rinse arm. Pull the wash arm. Remove both and clean.



STEP 5

Take apart



Remove centre support. Clean both sides.



Remove front support (located beneath the bottom edge of the door). Clean well both sides.



Turn the ring gasket on the centre post counter clockwise to remove. Clean it.



STEP 6

Manual cleaning



If not done already, clean and wash all removed parts. You are now ready to reassemble.

STEP 7

Reassemble



Put back ring gasket turning clockwise to lock position.



Put back the centre support.



Tighten the upper rinse arm gently.



Tighten the lower rinse arm gently.



Put back the overflow pipe.



Put back the front support.



Put back the upper wash and rinse arms.



Put back the lower wash and rinse arms.



Put back the pump filter turning clockwise to lock position.



Put back the strainer pan.



Now the unit is ready to operate or to switch off.
