
#### Tools required for installation:

- standard Phillips screwdriver (or electric screwdriver with variable torque setting) Note: If an electric screwdriver is being used, and is torque-adjustable, set it to the lowest torque setting to avoid over-tightening and stripping the screws.



• #10 x 1/2" sheet metal screws, zinc-plated




## Step 1 - Mark holes for 1st upright.




## Step 2 - Punch holes.

Remove upright and make small punch hole at each mark, no larger than \%2"-diameter, with the awl.

IMPORTANT: Do not drill mounting holes!

## Step 1 - Mark holes for 1st upright.




## Step 2 - Drill holes.

Remove upright.With awl, center-punch each mark


so that the drill bit does not "walk".

• Drill a 11/64" hole at each center-punched mark.



# Step 3 - Refer to the illustration above to determine location(s) of remaining upright(s), and repeat Steps 1 and 2.




